

## ERASMUSUS POLICY STATEMENT

- Individual Level

The enhanced multicultural awareness and social responsibility, internationalized perspective and reinforced skill-set and competencies will bring positive impact on both personal and professional development of the participants.

The cooperation projects will strengthen the capacities of the individuals and inspire their creativity and innovation during the multi-partnership collaboration.

- **Inter-Community Level**  
Both the mobility activities and cooperation projects will stimulate the movements of people who promote business and cultural exchanges between local communities on both sides. Good practices on digital transformation, inclusion and diversity, green transition and sustainability, civic engagement will also be exchanged and promoted at the community level. The general public will be sensitized to the Erasmus+ Program and its values.
- **Institutional Level**  
Our institution will be able to undertake a complete transformation to the ECTS credits system thanks to the recommendations of the ECTS Users' Guide. The automatic recognition of credits process will provide us with opportunities to create synergies and to advance modernization and digital transformation in terms of course module engineering, quality monitoring and evaluation methodology.  
The European Student Card Initiative (ESCI) will guide our school and service teams towards a more efficient and greener process and administrative standard.  
The variety of mobility formats put forward by the Erasmus+ program will allow us to explore and test innovative pedagogical tools and collaboration conditions, while cooperation projects will boost the direction and progress of scientific research in our institution and open possibilities to develop new disciplines and study programs and open new opportunities to join forces in other European Universities Initiative.
- **International Level**
