Housing

The students are responsible to arrange their own accommodation during the mobility. The International Office will provide information and suggestion upon request.

Below is some general information for reference:

- In residence hall of the CROUS: From 270 to 650 € / month excluding charges
- 9m² room: private washrooms/Bed, desk, wardrobe/closet, shelves, chair, washbasin, shared kitchen): from 270 € to 310 € / month
- 12-20m² room: private shower, toilet and washbasin/Bed, desk, wardrobe/closet, shelves, shelves, chair / Private kitchenette): from 400€/month
- Studio: from 500 € /month

- In private student residence: Students may choose to live in private housing; costs in Paris and Grand Parisian Region range from 500 to 900 € / month
- Rental of a studio (private rental): about from 650 € +/- month
- Room in a shared flat: around 400 €
- Renting a room with the inhabitant (private rental): around 300 € / month

Health Insurance

Health insurance is mandatory in order to study in France.
